I would consider instead of buying, swapping with gently used large wire and/or plastic crates I have on hand

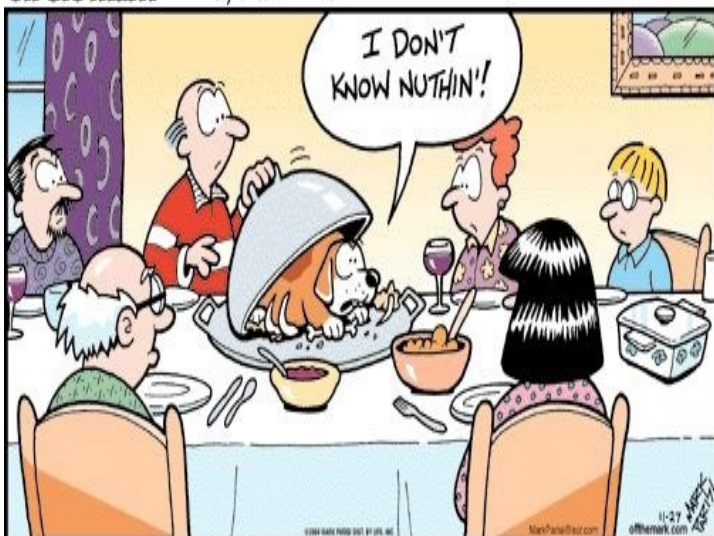
