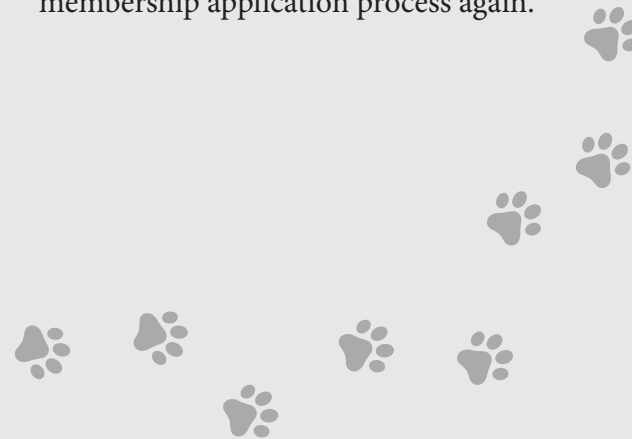
Annual Dues are Due
